Now lets hear from Miss Katherine Tate, the State Vice President all the way from Region 9!

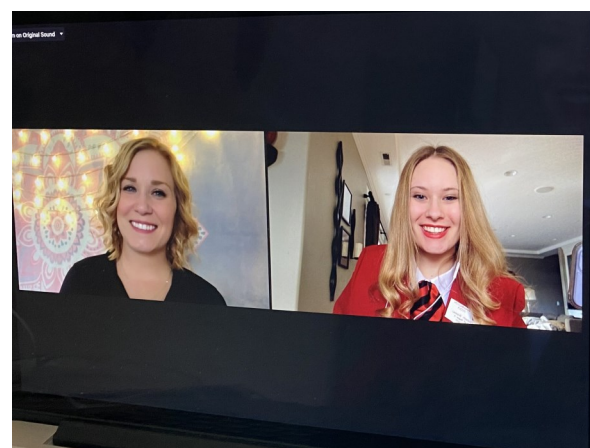
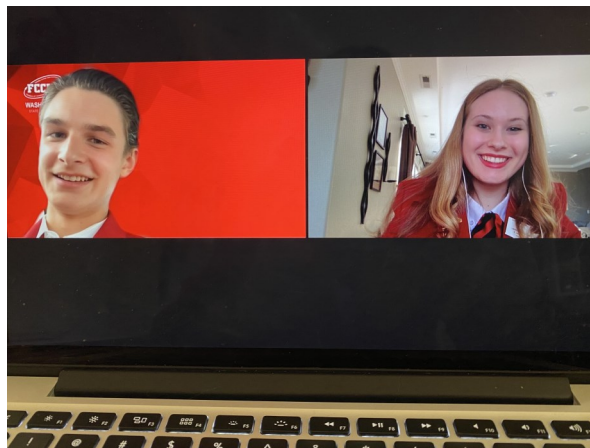
