# Celebrations

- Celebrate with us! NLC – 7 students earned first place at NLC, Washington had 33 Gold, 37 Silver, and 9 Bronze Medals at this year's NLC
- Record membership in 2021-22 with 6,214 total members



# Membership Fees

- Membership packages will be offered this year
  - 25 member package: State fee \$275; National fee is \$395; plus \$11 state level adviser dues. Regular fees for all members after 25 (state is \$11; national is \$9)
  - Unlimited package: State fee \$900; National fee is \$775; plus \$11 state level adviser dues.
  - 100% Middle Level: State fee \$300; National fee is \$250; plus \$11 state level adviser dues and \$9 national level adviser dues.
- We have seen great success with the membership packages, especially using alternate funding sources

- November 1 Deadline in order to maintain uninterrupted access to competitive events and additional resources
- Be sure to check out the resources area of the portal for most of your needed chapter resources.
- It is important to sign in as early as possible in the year to make sure we have your most current information

# Competitive Events

- Dress Code: Professional attire is no longer permitted. FCCLA official dress or costumes/chefs' attire (when applicable) are only acceptable
- FCCLA Planning Process: Now worth 10 points (previously 5) on rubrics
- Leadership: Book component now required. A rotating list of suggested books is available on the portal.



# Competitive Events

- Point Summary Form:
  - Registration Packet: Now worth 1 pt (previously 3)
  - Event Online Orientation: Now worth 1 pt (previously 2)
- Name Changes:
  - Teach and Train is now Teach or Train
    - This has always specified that members either focus on teach or train, they do not do both.
  - Promote and Publicize FCCLA! Is now Promote and Publicize FCCLA
    - Removed the (!) As there was no official reason to need it.



# Competitive Events

- Online Orientation Form
  - For national level competition, the online orientation form no longer needs to be printed and signed. The national office will pull a report after the June 15 deadline and automatically add the points to the point summary form.
  - Note: The Online Project Summary form is still required to be printed.
- New FAQ document:
  - Portal>Resources>Competitive Events
  - This document is being updated as questions come into the national office
  - In addition to the FAQ document located in the STAR Events Guidelines
